5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the establishment of a program
7 for assistance for housing and related facilities for
8 Alaskans who are unable to finance such housing; and
9 providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. The governor is authorized to prepare a state housing
12 program for submission to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development
13 pursuant to Title 10, Section 1004, Public Law 89-754, 80 Stat. 1285 (1966).
14 Such program shall provide housing and related facilities for Alaskan resi-
15 dents in rural areas upon terms and conditions they can afford.

16 * Sec. 2. The program shall:

17 (1) specify the minimum and maximum standards for such housing
18 and related facilities (not to exceed an average of \$7,500 per dwelling
19 unit);

20 (2) to the extent feasible, encourage the proposed users of such
21 housing and related facilities to utilize mutual and self-help in the con-
22 struction thereof; and

23 (3) provide experience, and encourage continued participation,
24 in self-government and individual home ownership.

25 * Sec. 3. The governor is authorized to designate an agency of the
26 state or a public corporate authority of the state to carry out this pro-
27 gram. The designated organization may accept grants or apply for an
28 receive loans under Title 10, Section 1004(A), Public Law 89-754, 80 Stat.
29 1285 (1966).

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* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage or on the day it becomes law without approval.
