5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the incorporation of third class
7 boroughs for school purposes; and providing for an
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 07 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

11 CHAPTER 33. THIRD CLASS BOROUGHES.

12 Sec. 07.33.010. EFFECT OF CHAPTER. Third class organized
13 boroughs may be incorporated for school purposes as provided in this
14 chapter. Provisions of law relating to first and second class organized
15 boroughs apply with respect to third class boroughs only if and to
16 the extent they are consistent with this chapter.

17 Sec. 07.33.020. POWERS OF THIRD CLASS BOROUGH. The third class
18 borough shall exercise only the areawide power of education as provided
19 for first and second class boroughs under AS 07.15.390. The borough
20 may not exercise other powers granted a first or second class organized
21 borough, whether granted either on an areawide basis or in the area
22 outside cities only.

23 Sec. 07.33.030. SCHOOL BOARD TO SERVE AS ASSEMBLY. (a) The
24 borough school board, elected as provided in this title and under
25 AS 14.12, shall be the assembly of the third class borough. The
26 board shall be composed and elected as provided in this title and
27 under AS 14.12, except that each city of the first class, whether
28 general law or home rule, shall be represented on the assembly by a
29 number of city council members reflecting the proportion which the

1 city's population bears to the total borough population. Each city
2 of the first class, whether general law or home rule, shall be
3 represented on the assembly by at least one member of its council.

4 (b) The school board shall organize and function as provided
5 for school boards generally under AS 14.14 and the provisions of
6 this title, except that the board shall exercise as well the powers
7 of the borough assembly with respect to education. However, weighted
8 voting shall not apply to assembly decisions.

9 (c) The president of the school board shall serve as chairman
10 of the third class borough and shall be chosen and serve in the
11 manner of other school board presidents, except that he shall exercise
12 as well the powers conferred under this title upon the borough chairman
13 with respect to education.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 07.35.010 is amended to read:

15 Sec. 07.35.010. CLASSIFICATION. Organized boroughs incorporated
16 under this title are either first class, [OR] second class, or third
17 class boroughs. The first class borough is a general law borough and
18 the second class borough is an optional law borough. The third class
19 borough is an organized borough for school purposes only. Original
20 classification is determined by the petition for incorporation approved
21 by the voters for incorporation. The unorganized borough established
22 by this title is unclassified. Unless clearly not applicable, the
23 terms "borough" and "organized borough," as used in this title mean
24 [BOTH] a first class, [OR] second class, or third class organized
25 borough.

26 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1967.
