FIFTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act limiting the frequency of elections for the incorporation of boroughs; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 07.10.010 is amended to read:

Sec. 07.10.010. INCORPORATION PROPOSED BY PETITION. The incorporation of a first- or second-class organized borough by local option is proposed by filing a petition with the Local Affairs Agency. The agency may not accept a petition proposing incorporation of an area, or part of an area, in which an election for borough incorporation has been held within 180 days preceding the date of filing of the petition.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
