6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to workmen's compensation for
7 volunteer firemen."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.30.220 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (5) if a member of a volunteer firefighting organization is
11 injured while performing his duties as a volunteer fireman, the wage
12 for calculating compensation shall be the minimum wage paid a full-
13 time fireman in the political subdivision where the injury occurred,
14 or if the subdivision has no full-time firemen employed, the wage for
15 calculating compensation shall be one and three-quarters times the
16 state minimum full-time wage computed on the basis of 40 hours work
17 per week.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 23.30.265 is amended by adding new paragraphs to read:

19 (24) "volunteer fireman" means an individual whose name is
20 registered with the state fire marshal as a member of a regularly
21 organized volunteer fire department;

22 (25) "regularly organized volunteer fire department" means a
23 volunteer fire department registered with the state fire marshal which
24 has official recognition and financial support from the political sub-
25 division where it is situated.
