6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to aid for dependent children; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 47.25.320(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The department shall determine the amount of assistance for  
11 a dependent child and the relative with whom the dependent child is  
12 living, with regard to the resources and necessary expenditures of the  
13 family and the condition existing in each case. Assistance is suf-  
14 ficient if, when added to all other income and support available to the  
15 child, the child and relative have reasonable subsistence compatible  
16 with decency and health. However, the amount of assistance shall not  
17 exceed \$100 [\$80] when there is a relative and one child. If there is  
18 more than one child, the amount allowed for the relative and first  
19 child shall not exceed \$100 [\$80], and the amount for each additional  
20 child shall not exceed \$50 [\$30].
