6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to fixed structures in Bristol Bay."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

9 CHAPTER 7. FIXED STRUCTURES IN BRISTOL BAY.

10 Sec. 16.07.010. PROHIBITION OF FIXED STRUCTURES. No fixed or
11 stationary structure which protrudes above the water may be erected
12 after the effective date of this chapter within the boundaries of the
13 gill net areas of Bristol Bay as defined by sec. 104.03 of the 1967
14 Fish and Game Regulations.

15 Sec. 16.07.020. PENALTY FOR VIOLATION. (a) A person who violates
16 sec. 10 of this chapter, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine of
17 not more than \$5,000.

18 (b) If a person is convicted of violating sec. 10 of this chapter
19 and wilfully fails thereafter to make reasonable efforts to remove
20 the offending structure, then the structure may be considered a
21 nuisance and consequently subject to abatement.

22 (c) A person who violates sec. 10 of this chapter is liable for
23 damages which result from this violation.
