5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the construction of a school at
7 Yakutat; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Subject to sec. 2 of this Act, the Department of Public
10 Works, referred to hereafter as the "department", shall construct a school
11 at Yakutat according to plans prepared by it and approved by the city of
12 Yakutat, referred to hereafter as the "city". The entire construction cost,
13 including design and planning, may not exceed \$500,000.

14 * Sec. 2. The city and the department shall, before any work is begun on
15 the school authorized by this Act, enter into an agreement in writing by
16 which

17 (1) the department agrees to build a school as provided by this
18 Act;

19 (2) the city agrees, before construction begins, to convey to the
20 department the land upon which the school is to be built; and

21 (3) other matters relating to the construction which are con-
22 sidered important by the city or the department are mutually agreed upon.

23 * Sec. 3. When the building is completed, the department shall reconvey
24 the land with the building to the city.

25 * Sec. 4. Beginning July 1, 1968, the commissioner of education shall
26 pay annually to the general fund money to which the city becomes entitled
27 from cigarette tax receipts in the "school fund" as provided by the formula
28 set out in sec. 125(c)(2), subchapter 14, Title 4, Alaska Administrative
29 Code, until the amount paid to the general fund amounts to \$500,000. No

1 money from this source shall be paid to the city until the required payment
2 to the general fund has been made.

3 * Sec. 5. The sum of \$500,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
4 the Department of Public Works for the construction authorized by this Act.

5 * Sec. 6. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
6 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
