5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to dental laboratories."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 08 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

9 CHAPTER 34. DENTAL LABORATORIES.

10 Sec. 08.34.010. REGISTRATION. No person, firm or corporation
11 may operate a dental laboratory in this state without a registration
12 certificate.

13 Sec. 08.34.020. APPLICATION AND FEE. Application for a registra-
14 tion certificate accompanied by a fee of \$25 shall be made to the
15 central licensing section of the Department of Commerce on forms pro-
16 vided by the department.

17 Sec. 08.34.030. REGISTRATION. If the applicant passes the
18 standards established by the board, the board shall register the
19 dental laboratory and issue a certificate.

20 Sec. 08.34.040. BIENNIAL REGISTRATION. Every certified dental
21 laboratory shall re-register with the central licensing section on or
22 before January 1 of every other year and pay a fee of \$30.

23 Sec. 08.34.050. DELINQUENCY FEE. Any dental laboratory operator
24 who has not complied with sec. 40 of this chapter by February 1 of the
25 year in which registration is required shall be required to pay a
26 delinquency fee of \$25 in addition to the regular biennial registration
27 fee.

28 Sec. 08.34.060. CHANGE IN OWNERSHIP OR ADDRESS. When the owner-
29 ship or address of any dental laboratory is changed, the owner shall

1 notify the secretary-treasurer of the board within 30 days of the
2 change of ownership or address.

3 Sec. 08.34.070. PERIODIC INSPECTIONS. The board may require
4 the applicant for a registration certificate to supply any information
5 necessary to carry out the purposes of this chapter.

6 Sec. 08.34.080. SUSPENSION AND REVOCATION. The board may suspend
7 or revoke the certificate of any dental laboratory for failure to comply
8 with this chapter or the regulations of the board.

9 Sec. 08.34.090. POWER OF THE BOARD. The board shall have the
10 power to enforce the provisions of this chapter and make, alter, or
11 amend the rules and regulation necessary or desirable to make the
12 provisions of this chapter effective.

13 Sec. 08.34.100. PENALTIES. Violation of a provision of this
14 chapter shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be
15 punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for
16 not more than one year, or by both.

17 Sec. 08.34.110. DEFINITIONS. As used in this chapter

18 (1) "board" means the Board of Dental Examiners;

19 (2) "dental laboratory" means a person, firm, or corporation,
20 other than a dental technician employed in the office of a licensed
21 dentist, that supplies or manufactures artificial substitutes for the
22 natural teeth, or who furnishes, supplies, constructs or reproduces or
23 repairs any prosthetic denture, bridge or appliance to be worn in the
24 human mouth.
