6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to dental hygienists."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 08.32.040 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 08.32.040. APPLICATION AND FEE. An application for quali-
10 fication shall be accompanied by the applicant's certificate of gradu-
11 ation, and a fee of \$25 [10].

12 * Sec. 2. AS 08.32.070 is amended to read:

13 Sec. 08.32.070. REGISTRATION AND LICENSING OF DENTAL HYGIENISTS.
14 If the applicant passes the examination, the board shall register him
15 and issue a certificate. The fee for registration is \$25 [10] every
16 other year. [BEFORE MAY 1 IN EACH YEAR, EVERY REGISTERED DENTAL
17 HYGIENIST SHALL PAY A REGISTRATION FEE OF \$10.]

18 * Sec. 3. AS 08.32.080 is amended to read:

19 Sec. 08.32.080. LAPSE AND REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE. The failure,
20 neglect, or refusal of a licensed dental hygienist to pay the biennial
21 [ANNUAL] registration fee constitutes a forfeiture of the license. The
22 board may reinstate the license upon written application and payment of
23 \$25 [10].

24 * Sec. 4. AS 08.32.090 is amended to read:

25 Sec. 08.32.090. TEMPORARY LICENSE. The board may issue a tempor-
26 ary license, without examination, to a person qualified to take the
27 examination. [THE TEMPORARY LICENSE RESTRICTS THE LICENSEE TO PRACTICE
28 AS A DENTAL HYGIENIST IN THE EMPLOY OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED
29 STATES OR THE STATE OR AN INCORPORATED ELEEMOSYNARY DISPENSARY OR

1 INFIRMARY, PRIVATE SCHOOL OR WELFARE CENTER.] The temporary license
2 granted to a hygienist in the employ of a privately practicing dentist
3 terminates when the results of the next board examination which the
4 person is eligible to take are released. The temporary license of all
5 other persons employed as hygienists terminates when the temporary
6 licensee takes the examination. Time spent on a temporary license does
7 not count toward license by reciprocity. The board may revoke a
8 temporary license at any time.

9 * Sec. 5. AS 08.32 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 Sec. 08.32.185. RULES AND REGULATIONS. The Board of Dental
11 Examiners may promulgate rules and regulations relating to the practice
12 of dental hygiene necessary to effectuate the purposes of this chapter.

13 Sec. 08.32.187. APPLICABILITY OF ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT.
14 Procedures and rules and regulations adopted under this chapter shall
15 comply with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62).
