6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting the use of the State Seal for
7 advertising or commercial purposes."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.60 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 11.60.225. IMPROPER USE OF STATE SEAL. (a) It is unlawful
11 for a person, firm, association or corporation to use or make a die or
12 impression of the state seal for any advertising or commercial purpose,
13 unless written permission has first been obtained from the secretary
14 of state.

15 (b) Violation of this section constitutes a misdemeanor, and
16 upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500, or by
17 imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both.
