6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the proclamation of martial law."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 26.05.090 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 Sec. 26.05.090. PROCLAMATIONS OF MARTIAL LAW. The governor may  
10 proclaim martial law when the public safety requires it in case of re-  
11 bellion or actual or imminent invasion, and may order all or any part  
12 of the organized militia into active state service to enforce the  
13 proclamation. The militia shall assume only those functions of civil  
14 government specified by the governor, or those which, in the discretion  
15 of the militia commander, must be assumed in order to accomplish a  
16 specific mission assigned by the governor. Martial law may not continue  
17 for longer than 20 days without the approval of a majority of the  
18 members of the legislature in joint session.
