6 For an Act entitled: "An Act reorganizing the Alaska militia."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 26.05.010 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 26.05.010. ALASKA MILITIA ESTABLISHED. (a) The militia
10 of the state consists of all able-bodied male citizens of the United
11 States and all other able-bodied males who have declared their in-
12 tention to become citizens of the United States, who reside in the
13 state, are 17 years of age or older and under 60, and who are not
14 exempt from military service under the laws of the United States or
15 this state [AND WHOSE AGE IS AS PRESCRIBED BY FEDERAL LAW].

16 (b) The militia shall be divided into two classes:

17 (1) the organized militia, consisting of [KNOWN AS] the
18 Alaska National Guard, the Alaska Naval Militia, and the Alaska State
19 Militia, and

20 (2) the unorganized militia, consisting of all qualified
21 persons available for service but not serving in the organized militia.

22 ■ Sec. 2. AS 26.05.030 is amended to read:

23 Sec. 26.05.030. COMPOSITION OF ORGANIZED MILITIA [ALASKA NATIONAL
24 GUARD]. (a) The Alaska National Guard consists of

25 (1) members of the militia who have voluntarily enlisted and
26 who, upon original enlistment, are organized, armed, equipped, and
27 federally recognized according to the laws of the United States; and

28 (2) commissioned officers and warrant officers who are
29 citizens of the United States, having the qualifications prescribed by

1 federal law and regulations, and who are appointed and commissioned or
2 warranted by the governor.

3 (b) Former members of the regular army, navy or marine corps
4 under 64 years of age may enlist in the Alaska Militia [NATIONAL
5 GUARD].

6 (c) The Alaska Naval Militia shall consist of units authorized
7 by the governor, organized, equipped, trained and administered as
8 prescribed by state and federal law and regulation, and manned by
9 personnel who are

10 (1) members of the United States Naval Reserve or the United
11 States Marine Corps Reserve and

12 (2) enlisted, appointed, commissioned or warranted under the
13 laws and regulations of the United States.

14 (d) The Alaska State Militia shall consist of units authorized
15 by the governor, and manned by volunteer personnel qualifying under
16 state law and regulation. All State Militia personnel shall be

17 (1) appointed, commissioned or warranted, and assigned by the
18 governor or the adjutant general as his designee;

19 (2) subject to serve on state active duty at the call and by
20 order of the governor.
