6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the Department of Public Safety  
7 to promulgate regulations regarding the acquisition  
8 and exchange of criminal information; and providing  
9 for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. AS 18.65.060 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 18.65.060. PEACE OFFICERS TO COOPERATE. (a) All police  
13 officers in the state or any municipality or subdivision shall  
14 cooperate with the Department of Public Safety in creating and main-  
15 taining its files, and all information shall be classified upon  
16 standard forms and kept available for the detection of crime and  
17 the identification of criminals.

18 (b) The Department of Public Safety may adopt regulations  
19 necessary to carry out the purposes of this section.

20 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
21 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
