6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the Department of Public Safety
7 to promulgate regulations regarding the acquisition
8 and exchange of criminal information; and providing
9 for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 18.65.060 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 18.65.060. PEACE OFFICERS TO COOPERATE. (a) All police
13 officers in the state or any municipality or subdivision shall
14 cooperate with the Department of Public Safety in creating and main-
15 taining its files, and all information shall be classified upon stan-
16 dard forms and kept available for the detection of crime and the
17 identification of criminals.

18 (b) The Department of Public Safety may adopt regulations necessary
19 to carry out the purposes of this section, provided that regulations
20 proposed by the department shall be submitted to the presiding officer
21 of each house on the day the house convenes. The legislature has 60
22 days of a regular session, or a full session if of shorter duration
23 to disapprove the proposed regulations. Unless disapproved by a special
24 concurrent resolution introduced in either house, concurred in by a
25 majority of the members in each house, the regulations become effective
26 at a date to be designated by the department.

27 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
28 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
