5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska State Housing Authority
7 redefining "veteran" for purposes of preference; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 18.55.470(5) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 (5) "veteran" means a person who has at any time resided
12 continuously for at least a year within the state and who served in
13 the armed forces of the United States for 90 days because of injury
14 or disability incurred in the line of duty, between:

15 (A) September 16, 1940 and July 25, 1947,

16 (B) June 25, 1950 and January 31, 1955, or

17 (C) August 4, 1964, and a date to be determined by
18 the legislature which shall be on or about six months after the
19 termination of hostilities involving forces of the United States
20 in Viet Nam.

21 "Veteran" also includes the spouse or widow or widower of a veteran.

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
23 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
