5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska State Housing Authority
7 re-defining 'veteran' for purposes of preference; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 16.55.470(5) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 (5) "veteran" means a person honorably separated from the
12 military service of the United States who has at any time resided con-
13 tinuously for at least a year in the state and who served in the armed
14 forces of the United States for at least 90 days or whose service was
15 for less than 90 days because of injury or disability incurred in the
16 line of duty, between (A) September 16, 1940 and July 25, 1947;
17 (B) June 25, 1950 and January 31, 1955; or (C) August 4, 1964, and a
18 date to be determined by the legislature which shall be on or about six
19 months after the termination of hostilities involving forces of the
20 United States in Viet Nam; "veteran" also includes the spouse or widow
21 or widower of a veteran.

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
23 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
