6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska Safety Council."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 44.19 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 44.19.805. SECRETARY. The governor shall designate a member
10 of his staff to serve as executive secretary of the council.

11 * Sec. 2. AS 44.19.820 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

12 Sec. 44.19.820. COMPOSITION OF COUNCIL. The council consists of
13 the following officials who shall serve without compensation:

14 (1) the secretary of state, or his representative, who shall
15 be chairman;

16 (2) the commissioner of public safety or his representative;

17 (3) the commissioner of highways or his representative;

18 (4) the commissioner of labor or his representative;

19 (5) a representative of the insurance industry, to be
20 appointed by the governor;

21 (6) not more than three representatives of local, or local
22 branches of national, recognized safety councils in the state, to be
23 appointed by the governor.

24 * Sec. 3. AS 44.19.830 is amended to read:

25 Sec. 44.19.830. REPORTS. The council shall report annually to
26 the governor and the legislature concerning the work of the council, and
27 shall make copies of these reports available to the news media and the
28 public.

29 * Sec. 4. AS 44.19.840 is amended to read:

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Sec. 44.19.840. QUORUM. Four [THREE] members of the council constitute a quorum.

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
