6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to frauds upon hotel keepers."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 11.20.480 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 11.20.480. DEFRAUDING HOTEL KEEPERS. A person who puts up
10 at a hotel, inn, boardinghouse, or lodginghouse and who procures a
11 fare, board, or lodging from the owner or keeper by means of a trick,
12 deception, or false representation, or a false show of baggage or ef-
13 fects, with the intent to cheat or defraud the owner or keeper out of
14 the pay for the fare, board, lodging, or accommodation; or who with
15 that intent absconds, surreptitiously removes, or causes to be removed
16 baggage or effects from a hotel, inn, boardinghouse, or lodginghouse
17 without first paying the proper charges due is guilty of a misdemeanor
18 if the amount of the fraud is \$100 or less, and upon conviction is
19 punishable by a fine of not more than \$200, or by imprisonment for not
20 more than six months, or by both; if the amount of the fraud is more
21 than \$100 the person is guilty of a felony and upon conviction is
22 punishable by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than 10
23 years. The words "fare, board, or lodging" do not include spirituous
24 or malt liquors or intoxicants of any description.
