BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 11.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 11.15.235. ASSAULT AND BATTERY ON LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIAL.

A person not armed with a dangerous weapon, who unlawfully strikes or wounds a policeman or law enforcement official who is at the time acting in the line of duty, is guilty of a felony and, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine of not more than \$2,000 nor less than \$100, or by imprisonment for not more than two years, or by both.
