6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the stealing, removing or damaging
7 parts of aircraft."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 11.20.525. STEALING, REMOVING OR DAMAGING PARTS OF AN AIRCRAFT.

11 (a) A person who wilfully or maliciously steals, removes, damages or in
12 any other manner interferes with any part of an aircraft without the con-
13 sent of owner shall be punished upon conviction by imprisonment for not
14 more than 10 years, or by a fine of not more than \$10,000, or by both.

15 (b) In this section "aircraft" means a device which was designed and
16 meant to be used for the transportation of person or property above the
17 surface of the earth or water.
