6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the stealing, removing or damaging
7 parts of aircraft."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 11.20.525. STEALING, REMOVING OR DAMAGING PARTS OF AN
11 AIRCRAFT. (a) A person who wilfully or maliciously steals, removes,
12 damages or in any other manner interferes with any part of an aircraft
13 without the consent of owner shall be punished upon conviction by
14 imprisonment for not more than 10 years, or by a fine of not more than
15 \$10,000, or by both, or by imprisonment in a jail for not more than one
16 year, or by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by both.

17 (b) In this section "aircraft" means a device which was designed
18 and meant to be used for the transportation of person or property
19 above the surface of the earth or water.
