6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the definition of 'teacher' in
7 the teachers' retirement system."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.25.220(15) is amended to read:

10 (15) "teacher" or "member" means a certified school nurse or
11 a certified teacher, principal, supervisor, or superintendent employed
12 on a full-time basis in the public schools of the state, the commissioner
13 of education, supervisors within the Department of Education, and all
14 full-time resident professional and administrative personnel of the
15 University of Alaska as designated by the Board of Regents; in case of
16 doubt, except as to personnel of the University of Alaska, the ad-
17 ministrators shall finally determine whether or not any person is a
18 teacher as defined in this chapter;
