5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating the Governor's Committee on Community
7 Growth; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.20 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 ARTICLE 2. GOVERNOR'S COMMITTEE ON COMMUNITY GROWTH.

11 Sec. 44.20.100. CREATION. There is created in the office of the
12 governor the Governor's Committee on Community Growth.

13 Sec. 44.20.110. COMPOSITION. The committee shall be composed of
14 11 members, five of whom shall be selected from the executive committee
15 of the Alaska municipal league, the chairman of the senate local govern-
16 ment committee, the chairman of the house local government committee,
17 the commissioner of administration, the commissioner of economic
18 development, the commissioner of highways and one representative of
19 the office of the governor.

20 Sec. 44.20.120. APPOINTMENT AND TERM OF MEMBERSHIP. Appointive
21 committee members shall be appointed by and shall serve at the pleasure
22 of the governor. Members who serve on the committee by virtue of
23 holding other offices shall be removed from the committee when they
24 no longer hold the office upon which their committee membership is
25 contingent. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner in which the
26 original appointment was made. The governor shall appoint a chairman
27 who is the principal executive officer of the committee.

28 Sec. 44.20.130. DUTIES. (a) The committee shall advise the
29 governor and his staff concerning the implementation of programs and

1 legislation to encourage community development and growth.

2 (b) The committee shall appoint subcommittees to study parti-
3 cular problem areas and make recommendations. One of the subcommittees
4 created shall be the municipal code subcommittee, which shall make a
5 comprehensive study of the laws of this state and recommend revisions
6 of or additions to the municipal code.

7 (c) The committee and individual subcommittees shall report to
8 the governor and the legislature annually, on or before the 1st of
9 January, and at such other times as either the governor or the
10 legislature may require. The annual report shall reflect all of
11 the activities of the committee, and recommend legislation by Congress
12 or this state to promote community growth.

13 Sec. 44.20.140. POWERS. The committee or a subcommittee is
14 empowered

15 (1) to apply for and receive gifts, grants or other aid
16 of whatever nature from public or private sources, and may use all
17 gifts, grants and aid subject to reasonable restrictions imposed by
18 the grantor;

19 (2) to employ consultants, legal, technical or clerical
20 assistants, and incur travelling and other miscellaneous expenses
21 incidental and necessary to the performance of its duties, within the
22 limit of funds appropriated or otherwise made available to it, and

23 (3) to conduct investigations and hearings to obtain
24 information which is not otherwise available, and which is necessary
25 to the performance of its duties under secs. 100 - 150 of this chapter.

26 Sec. 44.20.150. COMPENSATION. Members of the committee shall
27 serve without compensation, but shall receive the per diem and travel
28 allowance authorized by law for board or commission members.

29 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and

1 and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
