6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring the Department of Natural Resources
7 to convey title to certain real property to a certain
8 named individual; and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. The legislature finds that it is in the best interest of the
11 state to convey a particular parcel of real property near Haines to William
12 E. Nigh, that under existing general law the state is not obligated to make
13 a conveyance which is satisfactory in this situation, and that any reason-
14 able general law which the legislature might enact would be inapplicable in
15 this situation. The legislature further finds that the present situation is
16 of a unique nature and that the necessary and desirable conveyance can be
17 accomplished only by a special act of the legislature.

18 * Sec. 2. The director of the division of lands of the Department of
19 Natural Resources shall convey to William E. Nigh, 407 Irwin Street, Juneau,
20 Alaska 99801, all of the state's right and title, excluding mineral rights,
21 to the following property: T31S, R59E, CRM, Section 11, Lot 15.

22 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
23 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
