6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the first degree murder of a  
7 peace officer."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 11.15.010 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 11.15.010. FIRST DEGREE MURDER. A person who, being of  
11 sound memory and discretion, purposely, and either of deliberate and  
12 premeditated malice or by means of poison, or in perpetrating or in  
13 attempting to perpetrate, rape, arson, robbery, or burglary kills  
14 another, is guilty of murder in the first degree, and shall be sen-  
15 tenced to imprisonment for not less than 20 years to life, except that  
16 a person who is guilty of murder in the first degree of a peace officer  
17 may be punishable by death.
