For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to accumulated sick leave in computing
teachers' retirement benefits."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.25.220(5) is amended to read:

(5) "membership service" means service as a teacher in a

11

public school within the Territory or State of Alaska or both under the

12

supervision and control of the Territorial Board of Education or the

13

Department of Education, the school board of any borough school district

14

incorporated city, incorporated school district, independent school

15

district, or the Board of Regents of the University of Alaska, or any

16

period during which the teacher is on an approved sabbatical leave

17

granted in accordance with AS 14.20.310, [OR] is receiving a disability

18

retirement salary, or has accumulated sick leave at the time of becoming

19

eligible for retirement;

* Sec. 2. AS 14.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 14.25.081. CONTRIBUTIONS ON ACCUMULATED SICK LEAVE. When a

22

teacher retires under this chapter and the retiring teacher has accumu-

23

lated sick leave this leave shall be computed on a daily basis in

24

determining the teacher's retirement benefits. The employer shall

25

contribute his share under sec. 70 of this chapter to cover this leave

26

as well as the percentage contribution which would normally be made by

27

the teacher under sec. 50 of this chapter and the state shall contribute

28

its share under sec. 80 of this chapter to cover this leave.
