6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to proof of residency under fish  
7 and game laws."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 16.05.330 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.330. (a) LICENSES AND TAGS REQUIRED. It is unlawful,  
11 except as otherwise permitted in this chapter, for a person to engage  
12 in sport fishing including the taking of razor clams, hunting, trapping,  
13 guiding, fur dealing, fish, fur, or game farming, or taxidermy without  
14 the appropriate license or tag and without having them in his actual  
15 possession.

16 (b) In obtaining the "appropriate" license or tag in (a) of this  
17 section it shall be incumbent on the applicant, where he asserts  
18 residency in the state, to provide the license vendor with that proof  
19 of his residence which the department requires by regulations.

21 Sec. 16.05.480. (a) COMMERCIAL FISHING LICENSE. A person engaged  
22 in commercial fishing shall obtain a commercial fishing license. The  
23 fee for the license is \$10 for residents, and \$30 for nonresidents.  
24 All commercial fishing licenses are nontransferable and shall be re-  
25 tained in the possession of the licensee, readily accessible for in-  
26 spection at all times.

27 (b) A person applying for a resident commercial license under  
28 this section shall provide that proof of his residence which the  
29 department requires by regulations.
