6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to voter qualifications for new
7 residents in presidential elections.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 15.05.012 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 15.05.012. VOTER QUALIFICATION FOR NEW RESIDENTS IN PRESI-
11 DENTIAL ELECTIONS [ELECTION]. A person who has been a resident of this
12 state for less than one year before the date of a presidential election
13 is entitled to vote for presidential and vice-presidential candidates
14 in the election if he

15 (1) was a qualified voter in another state immediately prior
16 to his removal to this state; and

17 (2) would be a qualified voter in this state except that he
18 has not resided in the state for one year [MEETS THE QUALIFICATIONS OF
19 SEC. 10(1), (2) AND (5) OF THIS CHAPTER, AND IS A RESIDENT OF THIS
20 STATE AT THE TIME OF THE ELECTION].
