6 For an Act entitled: 'An Act relating to voter qualifications for new
7 residents in presidential elections.'

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 15 05.012 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 15.05.012. VOTER QUALIFICATION FOR NEW RESIDENTS IN PRESI-
11 DENTIAL ELECTIONS [ELECTION]. A person who has been a resident of this
12 state for less than one year before but more than 30 days prior to
13 the date of a presidential election is entitled to vote for presidential
14 and vice-presidential candidates in the election if he

15 (1) was a qualified voter in another state immediately prior
16 to his removal to this state; and

17 (2) would be a qualified voter in this state except that
18 he has not resided in the state for one year [MEETS THE QUALIFICATIONS
19 OF SEC. 10(1), (2) AND (5) OF THIS CHAPTER, AND IS A RESIDENT OF THIS
20 STATE AT THE TIME OF THE ELECTION],.
