6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the establishment of the Alaska
7 Credit Card Crimes Act."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.20 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 ARTICLE 9. ALASKA CREDIT CARD CRIMES ACT.

11 Sec. 11.20.700. FALSE STATEMENT AS TO FINANCIAL CONDITION OR
12 IDENTITY. A person who makes or causes to be made any false statement
13 in writing, knowing it to be false and with intent that it be relied on,
14 respecting his identity or that of any other person, or his financial
15 condition or that of any other person, for the purpose of procuring
16 the issuance of a credit card, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon
17 conviction is punishable by imprisonment for a term not to exceed one
18 year, or by a fine not to exceed \$1,000, or by both.

19 Sec. 11.20.365. UNAUTHORIZED USE OF CREDIT CARDS. (a) A person
20 who uses or attempts to use a credit card for the purpose of obtaining
21 goods, property, services, or anything of value, knowing his use or
22 attempted use to be without the consent of the owner, upon conviction,
23 is punishable by imprisonment as follows:

24 (1) if the value involved is less than \$100, imprisonment
25 for not less than three months nor more than one year;

26 (2) if the value involved is \$100 or more, imprisonment
27 for not less than one year nor more than five years.

28 (b) "Credit card" means any instrument, whether in the form of a
29 card, booklet, plastic or metal substance, or the number or other

identifying description of the instrument, which is sold, issued, or otherwise distributed by a business organization or financial institution, for the use by the person or organization to whom it is issued for obtaining on credit goods, property, services, or anything of value.
