6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the state Board of Education
7 members."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.07.085(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The seven members of the board, [NO MORE THAN FOUR OF WHOM
11 SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE SAME POLITICAL PARTY AS THE GOVERNOR,] shall
12 be appointed by the governor, subject to confirmation by a majority
13 of the members of the legislature in joint session. In appointing
14 board members, the governor shall consider recommendations made by
15 recognized educational associations in the state.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 14.07.095 is amended to read:

17 Sec. 14.07.095. TERM OF OFFICE. The members of the board shall
18 be appointed for overlapping seven-year [FIVE-YEAR] terms commencing
19 February 1 of the year of appointment. A member appointed to fill a
20 vacancy serves for the unexpired term of the member he succeeds. A
21 vacancy occurring during a term of office is filled in the same manner
22 as the original appointment.

23 * Sec. 3. Upon initial appointment under this Act the members of the
24 state Board of Education shall be appointed for consecutive terms of office
25 from one through seven years.
