6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the sale of intoxicating liquor."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 04.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 04.10.141. SALE IN VIOLATION OF LOCAL OPTION. Notwithstand-
10 ing any other provision of this chapter, a person who unlawfully sells
11 or offers for sale an intoxicating liquor in an area where the local
12 option election has made these activities illegal is, upon conviction,
13 guilty of a felony and is punishable by imprisonment for a period not
14 to exceed five years, or by a fine not to exceed \$5,000, or by both.
