6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Yukon-Taiya Commission; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 44.20.020 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 44.20.020. DUTIES OF THE COMMISSION. The commission shall  
11 seek the initiation of a Joint United States-Canada study of the  
12 Yukon-Taiya hydroelectric project and related resources development.  
13 The commission is authorized to conduct studies, compile and publish  
14 information, and provide the good offices of the state for encouraging  
15 the development.

16 \* Sec. 2. AS 44.20.030 is amended to read:

17 Sec. 44.20.030. COMPOSITION OF COMMISSION. The Yukon-Taiya  
18 [DIVERSION PROJECT] commission shall consist of five [THREE] persons to  
19 be appointed by the governor. The governor shall appoint a chairman.  
20 Legislators shall be eligible for appointment to this commission.

21 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
22 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
