6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska Transportation Commis-  
7 sion and creating an appeal board to the commission."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 42.07.020 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 42.07.020. COMPOSITION AND QUALIFICATIONS. (a) The commis-  
11 sion consists of two [THREE] members.

12 (b) Members [TWO MEMBERS] of the commission are appointed by the  
13 governor, serve at his pleasure, and must be confirmed by a majority  
14 of the members of the legislature meeting in joint session. One member  
15 shall be qualified by experience or training in the field of air  
16 commerce and the other member shall be qualified by experience or  
17 training in surface transportation.

18 [(C) THE THIRD MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION IS THE COMMISSIONER OF  
19 COMMERCE.]

20 \* Sec. 2. AS 42.07.050 is amended to read:

21 Sec. 42.07.050. MEETINGS. The commission shall meet at the call  
22 of the chair [OR UPON A SIGNED REQUEST TO THE CHAIRMAN FROM THE OTHER  
23 TWO MEMBERS].

24 \* Sec. 3. AS 42.07.090(b) is repealed.

25 \* Sec. 4. AS 42.07 is amended by adding new sections to read:

26 Sec. 42.07.160. APPEAL BOARD. There is created within the Depart-  
27 ment of Commerce an appeal board to the Alaska Transportation Commission.

28 Sec. 42.07.170. COMPOSITION AND CHAIRMAN. (a) The appeal board  
29 consists of five members. Two members of the board are the members of

1 the commission designated in sec. 20(b) of this chapter. The remaining  
2 three members of the board are lay persons appointed by the governor.

3 (b) The governor shall appoint the chairman of the board, but he  
4 may not be the same person as the chairman of the commission. The  
5 chairman shall serve in that capacity for a term of one year, but a  
6 member may be appointed for successive terms as chairman.

7 Sec. 42.07.180. TERM OF OFFICE. (a) The term of office of the  
8 three lay members of the board is six years, except that the terms of  
9 the members initially appointed are as follows: one member for two  
10 years, one for four years, and one for six years.

11 (b) The term of office of the two members on the board who are  
12 also members of the commission is the same as their term on the com-  
13 mission.

14 Sec. 42.07.190. QUORUM. Three members of the board constitute a  
15 quorum for the transaction of business.

16 Sec. 42.07.200. RESTRICTIONS OF MEMBERS, OATH OF OFFICE, AND  
17 ANNUAL REPORT. The board is subject to the provisions of secs. 60,  
18 70, 90(c) and 140 of this chapter.

19 Sec. 42.07.210. REGULATIONS. The Department of Commerce shall  
20 promulgate complete regulations concerning meetings of the appeal  
21 board and procedures to be used on appeals from the commission to the  
22 board.  
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
