6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the limitation of regulatory  
7 power over agricultural commodities."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 42.10.020 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 42.10.020. EXEMPT VEHICLES AND COMMODITIES. This chapter  
11 shall apply to all vehicles unless specifically exempted by this  
12 section. This chapter, except when specifically otherwise provided,  
13 does not apply to

14 (1) motor vehicles operated exclusively in the transporta-  
15 tion of United States mail or in the transportation of newspapers or  
16 periodicals alone or in conjunction with an express service delivering  
17 packages not to exceed 100 pounds to any one receiver;

18 (2) motor vehicles owned and operated by the United States,  
19 the state, or a borough, city, town, or municipality in the state,  
20 or by a department of any of them, except when the vehicles are  
21 used to transport property of the general public for compensation in  
22 competition with other common carriers subject to this chapter, and  
23 to the extent regulation of vehicles operated by the United States is  
24 permitted by the laws of the United States;

25 (3) motor vehicles not exceeding a total gross weight of  
26 12,000 pounds, owned and operated by a rancher, farmer, or dairyman  
27 in the transportation of his own ranch, farm, or dairy products from  
28 the point of production to market or to the point of transportation  
29 to market, or of supplies, commodities, or equipment used on his own

ranch, farm, or dairy. Motor vehicles operating under this classification shall be identified as farm vehicles in accordance with regulations prescribed by the commissioner of revenue;

(4) carrying of property consisting of ordinary livestock, including livestock products and livestock feeds, and agricultural and horticultural commodities, not including manufactured products of those commodities but including fertilizers.

\* Sec. 2. AS 42.10.420 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(10) "property consisting of ordinary livestock and agricultural and horticultural commodities" includes those items included in sec. 20(4) of this chapter and those in 49 U.S.C. 303(b)(6), but excluding fish.
