6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to costs and expenses of surveys."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 38.10.030 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 38.10.030. COSTS AND EXPENSES OF SURVEYS. Money shall be
10 appropriated from the general fund in an amount to be determined from
11 time to time by the legislature to facilitate such work. Accounting
12 of all costs and expenses of the surveys shall be made to the municipal
13 corporation by the director periodically and a final accounting shall
14 be made upon patent of the lands to the municipal corporation. Costs
15 and expenses chargeable to the city shall include the actual amount
16 expended for the survey and a reasonable allocation of overhead, travel
17 and equipment expense. The total amount of costs and expenses shall be
18 repaid to the fund through the director by the municipal corporation
19 for whom the survey was made, with interest at six [FIVE] per cent a
20 year from the date of patent. The actual cost of survey of each
21 interior subdivision shall be determined by the director. For tracts
22 conveyed to a preference right holder, the state shall be reimbursed
23 by the municipal corporation in the amount of the survey costs of that
24 tract as determined by the director within 30 days after the transfer
25 of each tract. For tracts conveyed, leased or otherwise disposed of by
26 the municipal corporation, the fund shall be reimbursed by the municipa
27 corporation in an amount equal to 90 per cent of the gross proceeds of
28 the sale, lease or other disposal of each tract until the total amount
29 of the costs and expenses of the survey, with interest, due the state

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is paid. The total amount, with interest, shall be reimbursed to the state within five years from the date of patent.
