6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending the Water Pollution Control Act;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 46.05.230(2) is amended to read:

10 (2) "industrial waste" means a liquid, gaseous, solid, or
11 other waste substance or a combination of them resulting from process
12 of industry, manufacturing trade or business, or from the development
13 of natural resources; [HOWEVER, GRAVEL, SAND, MUD, OR EARTH TAKEN
14 FROM ITS ORIGINAL SITUS AND PUT THROUGH SLUICE BOXES, DREDGES, OR
15 OTHER DEVICES FOR THE WASHING AND RECOVERY OF THE PRECIOUS METAL
16 CONTAINED IN THEM AND REDEPOSITED IN THE SAME WATERSHED FROM WHICH
17 IT CAME IS NOT INDUSTRIAL WASTE;]

18 * Sec. 2. AS 46.05.230(5) is amended to read:

19 (5) "pollution" means the contamination or altering of
20 waters of the state in a manner which creates a nuisance or makes
21 waters unclean, or noxious, or impure, or unfit so that they are
22 actually or potentially harmful or detrimental or injurious to public
23 health, safety or welfare, to domestic, commercial, industrial, or
24 recreational use, or to livestock wild animals, bird, fish, or other
25 aquatic life; [THE RESULTS OF ACTIVITIES CONNECTED WITH GRAVEL-
26 WASHING PLANTS AND PLACER MINING OPERATIONS ARE NOT POLLUTION;]

27 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
28 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
