6 For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating money for erecting a building
7 for use by the Alaska Department of Labor,
8 Employment Security Division; and providing for an
9 effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. The sum of \$45,660.23 is appropriated out of funds made
12 available to this State under section 903 of the Social Security Act, as
13 amended, to the Department of Labor, for the purpose of acquiring land and
14 erecting buildings thereon for the use of the Employment Security Division
15 of the Department of Labor and for such improvements, facilities, paving,
16 landscaping, and fixed equipment as may be required for its proper use
17 and operation by the Employment Security Division of the Department of
18 Labor.

19 * Sec. 2. No part of the money hereby appropriated may be obligated
20 after the expiration of the two year period beginning on the date of
21 enactment of this Act.

22 * Sec. 3. The amount obligated pursuant to this Act during any fiscal
23 year shall not exceed the amount by which (a) the aggregate of the amounts
24 credited to the account of this State pursuant to section 903 of the
25 Social Security Act during such fiscal year and the nine preceding fiscal
26 years exceeds (b) the aggregate of the amounts obligated for administration
27 and paid out for benefits and charged against the amounts credited to the
28 account of this State during such ten fiscal years.

29 * Sec. 4. If any money appropriated under this Act is not expended, or

1 not obligated within the two year period specified in Section 2 of this Act,
2 said money shall revert back to the State's Unemployment Trust Fund.

3 * Sec. 5. This Act shall take effect and be in force on the day after
4 its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
