6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the publishing of the names of
7 parents whose child is found to have violated certain
8 laws; and amending the Supreme Court Rules of Juvenile
9 Procedure."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 47.10.090 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

12 (c) The names of the parents of a minor may be made public by a
13 newspaper, radio, or television station if the minor is found to have
14 violated, for the second time, any law which if committed by an adult
15 would be either a misdemeanor or a felony.

16 * Sec. 2. This Act changes Rule 26 of the Supreme Court Rules of
17 Juvenile Procedure in that the rule now provides that the names and pictures
18 of juveniles are not to be made public when the person is under the juris-
19 diction of the juvenile court and if this Act is passed the disclosure of
20 the parents' names will make it obvious who the child is.
