6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to taxidermy and fur dealing  
7 licenses; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 16.05.330 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (b) A license for taxidermy or fur dealing may be issued for an  
11 individual or for a business premise. An agent or employee may engage  
12 in taxidermy or fur dealing in and for a licensed business premise with-  
13 out an individual license, but each premise of an owner, and each in-  
14 dividual engaging in taxidermy or fur dealing outside of a licensed  
15 premise, must have a separate license. The applicant for a license for  
16 a business premise shall designate who is responsible for submitting  
17 reports in connection with the use of the license.

18 \* Sec. 2. AS 16.05.940(8) is amended to read:

19 (8) "fur dealing" means [ENGAGING IN THE BUSINESS OF] buying  
20 selling, or trading in animal skins. The term does not apply to a  
21 hunter or trapper selling the animal skins he has legally taken, or to  
22 a person, other than a fur dealer, purchasing animal skins for his own  
23 use;

24 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
25 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
