6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the sale of land to shore fisheries."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 38.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 38.05.066. PREFERENCE TO PERSONS FOR FISHERY PURPOSES. When,
10 in the judgment of the director with the concurrence of the commissioner,
11 it is determined that it would be in the best interests of the state
12 and reasonably necessary for the use and enjoyment of a shore fishery
13 lease, the director may sell an uplands tract of land not to exceed
14 five acres in size to the fishery lessee. The price of the land shall
15 be determined by the director based on the fair market value of the
16 tract at the time of the transaction. In order for a shore fishery
17 lessee to be eligible to purchase under this section, he must be presently
18 in actual or constructive occupancy of a site which was originally sanc-
19 tioned by a small tracts lease from the federal government which has
20 since been transferred to the jurisdiction of the state.
