6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the professions of guiding and  
7 outfitting; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 16.05.330 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.330. LICENSES AND TAGS REQUIRED. It is unlawful,  
11 except as otherwise permitted in this chapter, for a person to engage  
12 in sport fishing including the taking of razor clams, hunting, trapping,  
13 [GUIDING,] fur dealing, fish, fur, or game farming, or taxidermy with-  
14 out the appropriate license or tag and without having them in his  
15 actual possession.

16 \* Sec. 2. AS 16.50.120(a)(3) is amended to read:

17 (3) a person to guide as defined in this chapter without  
18 being licensed under this chapter and without having the license in  
19 his actual possession;

20 \* Sec. 3. AS 16.50.230(2) and AS 16.50.240(2) are repealed.

21 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
22 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
