11 MANPOWER DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING AND MANPOWER ADVISORY COMMITTEES.

12 Sec. 23.15.610. PARTICIPATION IN MANPOWER DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING  
13 ACT. In order to continue to participate in programs under the Manpower  
14 Development and Training Act of 1962 (42 U.S.C. 2571-2620), the Depart-  
15 ments of Labor and Education are each authorized to administer manpower  
16 development and training programs and to pay training allowances, to  
17 execute on behalf of the state agreements or contracts with the appro-  
18 priate federal agencies containing provisions which may be necessary or  
19 desirable to enable the state to participate in the programs, to expend  
20 all funds made available for the purpose of the programs by the state or  
21 local subdivisions of the state or by the federal government, to super-  
22 vise the expenditure of the funds and the conduct of the programs by  
23 other public and private agencies of the state, to establish manpower  
24 advisory committees on the state and local levels and to make the reports  
25 and certificates which are called for, and otherwise to cooperate with  
26 the federal government and its departments and agencies in the adminis-  
27 tration of the programs.
