6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to architectural plans and designs for
7 public buildings."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 35.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 35.10.011. ARCHITECTURAL PLANS AND DESIGNS. (a) The plans
11 and design submitted by an architect shall be drawn up so that reasonable
12 construction costs do not exceed the amount appropriated for the public
13 building. If the submitted plans and design cannot be reasonably bid
14 on within the amount of the existing appropriation, the submitting
15 architect shall redesign or replan or do both to the proposed public
16 building in order to bring the reasonable construction cost figure into
17 line with the appropriation. Redesigning or replanning or both re-
18 designing and replanning shall be done with no additional cost to the
19 state for architectural fees.

20 (b) "public building" as used in this section includes any build-
21 ing constructed in whole or in part with state funds.
