6 For an Act entitled: "An Act granting emergency urban renewal and redevelop-
7 ment authority to certain municipal entities; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 07.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 07.15.735. EMERGENCY DISASTER POWERS. (a) A second class
12 borough which is wholly or partially within an area which is declared
13 by the President to be a disaster area may participate in and provide
14 for housing and urban renewal and redevelopment in the same manner as
15 a city of the first class, provided that such powers are limited to an
16 area outside any city in the borough.

17 (b) The borough may exercise such powers for a housing or urban
18 renewal and redevelopment project as are transferred to it by a city
19 located within the borough as provided by sec. 910 of this chapter.

20 (c) Secs. 720 - 800 of this chapter are not applicable to the
21 housing and urban renewal and redevelopment powers granted by this
22 section.

23 (d) Powers granted by this section must be initiated within a
24 period of not more than one year from the date of declaration of a
25 natural disaster by the President, but these powers may be extended
26 for an additional period of not more than one year if an extension is
27 approved by a majority of the qualified voters. The powers granted by
28 this section are subject to initiative and referendum.

(g) The provisions of this section apply whenever an area has been declared by the President of the United States to be a disaster area and the legal governing body certifies that the need of the area for redevelopment or urban renewal has been substantially increased as a result of the natural disaster and all results and aftereffects, respecting which the governor has also certified the need for disaster assistance.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
