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FIFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

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A BILL

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For an Act entitled: "An Act granting emergency urban renewal and redevelopment authority to certain municipal entities; and providing for an effective date."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

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\* Section 1. AS 07.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

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Sec. 07.15.735. EMERGENCY DISASTER POWERS. (a) A second class borough or first or second class city which is wholly or partially within an area which is declared by the President to be a disaster area may participate in and provide for housing and urban renewal and redevelopment in the same manner as a Home Rule city, provided that the exercise of these powers by a borough are limited to the area outside any city in the borough.

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(b) A borough may exercise such powers for a housing or urban renewal and redevelopment project as are transferred to it by a city located within the borough as provided by sec. 910 of this chapter.

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(c) Secs. 720 - 800 of this chapter are not applicable to the housing and urban renewal and redevelopment powers granted by this section.

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(d) Powers granted by this section must be initiated within a period of not more than one year from the date of declaration of a natural disaster by the President, but these powers may be extended for an additional period of not more than one year if an extension is approved by a majority of the qualified voters. The powers granted by this section are subject to initiative and referendum.

2 (g) The provisions of this section apply whenever an area has  
3 been declared by the President of the United States to be a disaster  
4 area and the legal governing body certifies that the need of the area  
5 for redevelopment or urban renewal has been substantially increased as  
6 a result of the natural disaster and all results and aftereffects  
7 respecting which the governor has also certified the need for disaster  
8 assistance.

9 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
10 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
