8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS members of the Legislature find it increasingly difficult to
10 find adequate housing during legislative sessions for themselves and their
11 families; and

12 WHEREAS the local governments of the Greater Juneau Area, the Juneau
13 Chamber of Commerce, and interested individuals have been most cooperative
14 and helpful in trying to meet the annual demand for legislator housing; and

15 WHEREAS despite all efforts and cooperation thus far the problem of
16 legislator housing for three months each year remains acute and requires
17 further exploration to find mutually satisfactory solution in the future;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to make contact
19 with representatives of the state government, capital area governments and
20 organizations and interested individuals and groups to solicit suggestions
21 and proposals regarding the housing of legislators and their families in
22 the capital area during the annual legislative sessions in order that a
23 solution of benefit to the community's economy and the Legislature can be
24 found and implemented.
