5 Relating to the cooperation of the
6 fishing and canning industries in limit-
7 ing the units of fishing gear.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Alaska is cognizant of the
10 social and economic impact of an over abundance of fishing units in certain
11 fisheries of the state; and

12 WHEREAS the Legislature has expended many hours in attempting to draft
13 legislation which would correct the inequities inherent in these situations
14 and which would allow better quality control during periods of peak runs;
15 and

16 WHEREAS it is the desire of the Legislature to afford better protection
17 for the resources and citizens of the State of Alaska; and

18 WHEREAS the Legislature of the State of Alaska is convinced that this
19 matter can be more effectively and equitably resolved by the fishing and
20 canning industries;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the fishing and canning industries are urged to
22 conduct studies relative to the establishment of reasonable restraints on
23 the number of units of fishing gear engaged in the fisheries of Alaska and
24 to take whatever appropriate action is indicated by the studies.
