5 Relating to the payment of state  
6 employees for their services.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS many persons employed in private industry and all those em-  
9 ployed by the federal government receive payment for their services on a  
10 bimonthly basis; and

11 WHEREAS state employees are currently paid once each month; and

12 WHEREAS for many persons, the receipt of one paycheck a month creates  
13 severe economic hardship at the end of each pay period; and

14 WHEREAS many state employees have expressed the desire to be paid on a  
15 bimonthly basis; and

16 WHEREAS if state employees were paid bimonthly, the employees and the  
17 communities in which they live would both be benefited;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct  
19 the Department of Administration to institute a payroll system which would  
20 enable state employees to be paid twice a month at the earliest possible  
21 time.
