8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the employment security laws and programs of the state have
10 been developed over the years on the basis of federal laws and programs
11 first established thirty years ago; and

12 WHEREAS each year the Legislature is involved with proposals for piece-
13 meal amendment of the employment security laws without reference to an
14 overall review of the applicability of the general law and the federal
15 regulations to the current needs of the state and those affected by it; and

16 WHEREAS the Legislature would find a comprehensive review of the
17 employment security laws and programs useful in its deliberations and con-
18 siderations of related legislation;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council, with the full cooperation
20 of the Department of Labor, is directed to make a comprehensive review of
21 the employment security laws of the state and to make recommendations in
22 the form of a report and suggested legislation which may be needed to the
23 Fifth Legislature, Second Session for the improvement of the law. The
24 report shall include suggestions for change in the federal program which
25 the Legislature might wish to recommend to the Congress of the United States.
